I am fascinated by the weird strategies of evolution, the ethical questions of genetics and the spiritual quality of a casual walk in a forest.

While working I am often going back and forth between projects while mixing technices, thoughts and influences freely. I don't want to choose between cave paintings and VR - I think it all belongs together. My art is a reflection of our age: at the intersection between analog and digital techniques I try to expand the field of art and make the overlap of traditional expression and modern-era technologies as fluid as possible.










